TROPICANA

- To build organizational capacity through improved stability, planning, and oversight function by funding projects that:
- Increase Operational Management effectiveness and efficiency through improved human and financial resources management practices.
 - Enhance organizational governance to provide greater stability and improved planning and oversight function, specifically:
 1. Empowerment and accountability
 2. Service and fairness
 3. Accomplishment and measurements

- Provide project funding to Black-led organizations across Quebec in order to increase their organizational capacity.
- Support funded organizations and collaborate with partner organizations to enhance the capacity of Black-led and Black-serving organizations.
- Target and include the various black communities in Quebec with a view to creating a community of practice, sharing best practices; pool and develop tools and resources.



Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility to apply include:

- **A legal entity in Canada;**
- **A registered non for-profit organization; and**
- **A Black-led organization with a mandate to serve Black Canadian Communities.**

A Black-led organization must meet the following criteria:

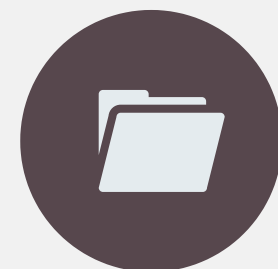
- **The leadership positions (Directors, Founders) are primarily occupied by people who self-identify as Black (minimum 2/3);**
- **The governance structure is primarily composed of people who self-identify as Black (minimum 2/3); and**
- **The mandate serves Black communities.**
