Upon course completion, student participants gain entry as an ECEA into a variety of childcare work settings such as School Age Care, Family Drop-In Centres, Childminding, & Licensed Child Care facilities, or start their own childcare business at home!

- a Canadian Citizen, or Permanent Resident, or Protected Person
- Resident of BC
- Unemployed / Underemployed
- Not registered in any other full time study programs
- Possess LINC Level 6 English proficiency
