We are seeking an experienced **ECE certificate holder** for an ongoing position at Kiwassa Variety Club Daycare. The successful applicant will offer innovative ideas and enthusiasm to our dynamic, inclusive, and multicultural program. This position reports to the Program Coordinator.

## **Responsibilities:**

- To be able to work within a team environment, and to provide a developmentally appropriate, play centred and inclusive program.
- To develop programming based on children's needs, interests and abilities.
- To attend to child's physical needs that may include toileting, eating, etc.
- Establish and maintain positive daily communication with family and other professionals.

- To show willingness of ongoing professional commitment and development, and an attitude that supports ongoing learning and self-reflection skills.
- To guide and care for children using positive and compassionate techniques
- To follow licensing regulations and Kiwassa's policy/procedures
